### Team composition

Junior, must be a minimum of 1 per team & a maximum of 2 per team

Senior, must be a minimum of 1 per team

Adult Woman must be a minimum of 1 per team

Adult Man, must be a minimum of 1 per team

### Definitions

Junior, age 21 or under as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025

Senior, age 50 or over as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025

Adult, age 22 or over as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025

### Team option 1

One Junior, (gender not applied)

One Senior, man or woman

Two Adults, man or woman

Adults/Senior cannot all be the same gender.

### Team option 2

Two Juniors, (gender not applied)

One Senior, man or woman

One Adult, man or woman

Adult/Senior cannot both be the same gender.

### Rules revised at 2023-24 AGM

#### General Rules

1. All four Provinces are required to form and enter three teams in this competition.
2. All players must be RCCC registered by their local Province club. The RCCC database will be checked as soon as possible.
3. All games will be 8 ends or the bell.
4. The 5 stone Free Guard Zone rule will apply. The no tick rule will not apply.
5. The winning Province is the highest up shots total of the three teams from that Province. Ties to be decided by total shots, then ends won.
6. All teams must complete the score cards in full including players names and skips signatures.
7. Score cards will be collected by an Area Representative at the end of the game.

#### Penalty Rules

1. An unregistered player causes the team to be disqualified. The game will be played and started on time. The defaulting team will be given no score. The Province of the defaulting team will have 3 shots and 4 ends taken off their score. The non defaulting team will be given a score of 3 shots and 4 ends or the actual game score whichever is the greater.
2. Team is not of correct composition. The offending team will be disqualified. The game will be played and started on time. The defaulting team will be given no score. The Province of the defaulting team will have 3 shots and 4 ends taken off their score. The non defaulting team will be given a score of 3 shots and 4 ends or the actual game score whichever is the greater.
3. Late arrival will be penalised 1 shot for each 5 minutes up to a maximum of 3 shots. The game is to be started on time. The defaulting team will have the penalty shots taken off their score in the game.
4. Three handed teams. The game is to be played and started on time. The defaulting team will have 3 shots taken off their score in the game.
5. Teams withdrawing for any reason after the draw has been circulated must inform their Province who then must inform the Area Secretary, Opposition, and Ice Rink concerned. The defaulting Province may also be responsible for ice fees.
6. Non-appearance of team/s. The Province of the defaulting team/s will be liable for the full cost of the ice.
